•	REQUIREMENTS	You must be a foreign national residing in Kagoshima Prefecture, and not have previously received the Grand Prize in this contest.		
•	MAX APPLICANTS	40 people (only individual applications are accepted).		
•	THEME	Anything except for RELIGION or POLITICS.		
•	TIME LENGTH	4 – 6 minutes. (Over ~1,100 Japanese characters)		
•	RESTRICTION	The use of props or sound effects is not permitted.		
•	EVALUATION	Pre-screening: Evaluated by the secretariat office		

**Pre-screening:** In principle, up to 40 participants will be selected based on the speech manuscript.

**Preliminary Round:** 10 participants will be selected to move forward to the contest.

**Contest:** Prizes will be awarded to selected participants.
